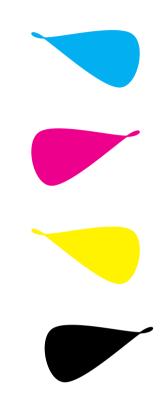

This structure allows clean label peeling without liner damage, delivering optimal efficiency for batch printing operations.

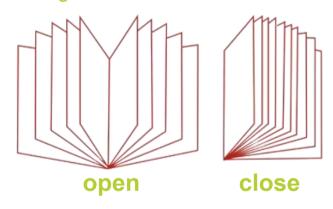
8 P (pages) manual

An 8-page (8P) manual, consisting of 4 double-sided sheets.



20 P (pages) manual

An 20-page (8P) manual, consisting of 10 double-sided sheets.



For manual (brochure) design, the page count for saddlestitched binding should ideally be a multiple of 4. For instance, if you design a 6P catalog, 2 blank pages will need to be added to make it 8P.

For perfect-bound catalogs, the page count should be a multiple of 2. For example, a 37P design would require adding 1 blank page to make it 38P.

In printing terms, 'P' (Page) counts single sides; a leaf is always 2P.

1P refers to one printed side, so a single sheet equals 2 pages (2P) — including both front and back covers in the total count.

Your 200-page booklet? That's consisting of 100 double-sided sheets. (200P total).

Saddle Stitch Binding Recommended for 8P-32P

Ideal for booklets with fewer pages or thinner paper, such as brochures, product catalogs, and company profiles. The page count must be a multiple of 4, with a maximum thickness of 32P (including cover and back, totaling 16 sheets). Saddle stitch binding is cost-effective and suitable for projects ranging from 8P to 32P.

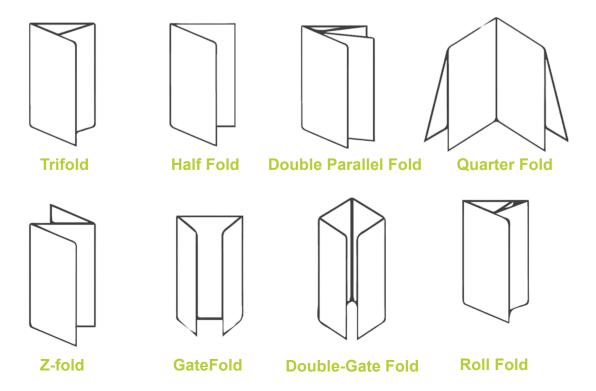
Perfect Binding Recommended for 36P–100P

Ideal for medium-page-count publications such as magazines, journals, brochures, product manuals, and company profiles. Perfect binding uses adhesive to securely bind the pages (P) into a clean, professional finish.

Minimum order starts at 36P (including cover and back, totaling 18 sheets), with a maximum thickness of 100P (50 sheets). Perfect binding is best suited for projects between 36P and 100P, and inner pages should not be overly thick.

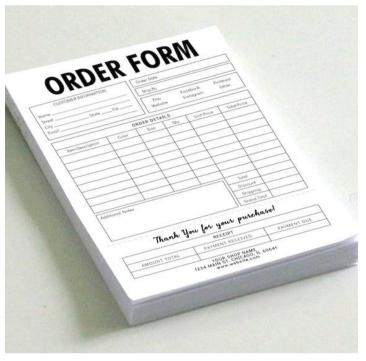
